

2023-2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

PHILOSOPHY

The NACS Foundation unifies and builds on NACS members' philanthropic priorities—amplifying the industry's power to propel tomorrow's industry leaders, in neighborhoods of all sizes, across America and beyond.

The convenience and fuel retailing industry has been built and sustained from individuals from all walks of life—many of our convenience industry leaders started their careers at the store level. Through hard work and commitment to learning, these employees followed career paths to senior leadership positions.

Since 1994, the NACS Foundation Future Fund's scholarship program has been providing convenience and fuel retailers a way to retain, reward, and develop the next generation of industry innovators within their companies. These scholarships help develop future retail leaders by providing them with \$3,000 toward tuition costs at undergraduate or community college institutions. Each recipient will also receive a stipend to attend the 2023 NACS Show in Atlanta at the Georgia World Congress Center, October 3-6, where they will be recognized during a special evening ceremony and given the first-hand opportunity to learn more about exciting career paths in the industry.

The NACS Foundation Scholarship honors industry icon Jim Yates, founder of E-Z Mart Stores, former NACS Chairman of the Board, and a pioneer in the industry. In 1999, Altria Distribution Group's donation expanded the scholarship to honor David Erickson, former CEO of Erickson Oil Products.

The NACS Foundation, a 501(c)3, which serves as a point of centralization and catalyzation – amplifying the reach, resonance, and impact of our supplier and convenience and fuel retail members' tremendous charitable efforts.

FUTURE FUND

The Future Fund, one of the NACS Foundation's five signature program areas, propels tomorrow's industry leaders. Through this program, the NACS Foundation invests in future leaders through scholarship and internship programs offered to c-store member employees and their children.

ELIGIBILITY

Employees that work for a NACS Retail Member company and are enrolled in/or will be enrolled in fall 2023 academic studies are eligible to apply for a scholarship. The applicant must be a current employee and continue to work for the nominating convenience retail company throughout the scholarship period (academic year: 2023-24).

AWARDS

There will be up to 11 NACS Foundation Scholarships awarded for one-year terms. Scholarship recipients may re-apply each year, for up to four years, if they continue to meet the eligibility requirements. The scholarships will be applied to tuition at any accredited, non-profit college or university in the United States. Recipients may transfer from one college to another and retain the award. Recipient must continue to work for the nominating company throughout the scholarship period.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To be considered for a scholarship, a candidate must complete an official NACS Foundation Scholarship application, which consists of the following three (3) parts:

- 1. Applicant Data and Questionnaire
- 2. Applicant Essay (two pages, maximum)
- 3. Nomination Form, to be completed by a supervisory employee / senior official within the company

Applications must be received by Monday, June 5, 2023

SELECTION OF WINNERS

NACS Foundation Scholarship winners are people in the industry who clearly demonstrate dedication to achieving excellence in retailing, strong leadership skills, potential for future growth as a leader, and persistence in the pursuit of education.

Applications will be reviewed by NACS staff members and winners will be selected based on the above criteria.

RESPONSIBILITY OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients must enroll as full undergraduate college students in the fall 2023 and continue to be in school for the entire academic year (2023-24) without interruption, barring illness, emergency, or military service. Recipients are responsible for ensuring the scholarship checks are delivered to the correct office at their college or university.

To be eligible for a NACS Foundation Scholarship award, the recipient must remain an employee of the NACS member company for the entire period of the award.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Two separate scholarship checks will be mailed to the recipient's home address, only made payable to the scholarship recipient's college or university for tuition-related expenses. The first award payment will be issued in August for \$1,500 and the second payment of \$1,500 will be distributed in December. (For colleges on the semester system, the checks are for one half of the award.)
